

General Plan for RCFHA Season

- Renting Elementary School Gyms from **October until May during weeknights**
 - **Use: For Team Practices**
 - Will **restrict practices to with social distant** drills (according to our safety plan) and with the **use of face shields**
 - No scrimmages until at least January (re-evaluate in December if it may be possible)

- Renting Burnett starting in **November until mid-December on Weekends**
 - **Use: Schedule teams to scrimmage in an Exhibition season using our Option 2 Social Distancing game play**
 - Using Option 2 in our Return to Play model, see Safety Plan for details
 - This is a modified game play
 - Cohort model will be used (only teams within the same cohort will be playing each other)
 - Face shields will be used throughout

- Renting Burnett starting in **January until May on Weekends**
 - **Use: Regular Season and Tournament**
 - Using Option 1 in our Return to Play model
 - This is our regular play without social distancing
 - Face shields will be used throughout
 - Please see the Safety Plan for more details
 - **Note: If necessary, we will revert to Option 2/Option 3 if necessary to continue games**

- Notes
 - The above is taking into account the recent developments where viaSport and the BC Government has announced we are in Phase 3 of Return to Play
 - We are a contact-less league as per our regular rules to begin with
 - Compared to other sports, this makes our sport a safer option than others
 - We have tested models and social distancing while playing in a test model where we rented the Burnett Lacrosse Box with the City of Richmond during the summer
 - There is no travel in our league, all games are played at Burnett, and all practices occur in Richmond Elementary schools
 - Division cohorts will have a maximum of 4 – 5 teams consisting of a maximum of 15 players per team, coaches, Safety Managers, and scorekeepers
 - We are open to using any of the models we have listed in our Safety Plan to comply with Vancouver Coastal Health regulations and the City of Richmond
 - We are prepared to use any of the options we have listed, and if recommended to use one option over another, we will do so

Summary: We believe with our limited contact in Cosom Hockey, our use of face shields throughout our season, and our cohort model is a safe plan using the following timeline with our hockey models

- **Option 2 to be used in November and December**
- **Option 1 to be used in January until May**
