As a member in good standing of the Richmond Cosom Floor Hockey Association, I accept responsibility for my behaviour. Furthermore, I agree that:

- I will recognize that coaches and team managers are volunteers who are giving their time and effort so that my child can play floor hockey;
- I will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from our children's floor hockey games whether on the floor or in the stands;
- I will set a high standard of acceptable behaviour and encourage my child and all players to play by the rules of Floor Hockey as determined by the Richmond Cosom Floor Hockey Association (refer to the League Handbook on our website: www.rcfha.org):

 _I will observe the RCFHA "24-hour rule" when I feel there is an issue that I must address with my child's coaches, team manager or others in the association. Give yourself 24 hours before you present your concerns;
- I will support the decisions made by the on-floor officials regardless of my personal opinions (officials are often children themselves, and part of learning is making decisions that I will accept with grace and good sportsmanship);
- As a coach, assistant coach or team manager it is my responsibility to not only observe the above points but to promote sportsmanship and respect for all players, referees, parents and volunteers.

I understand that should I engage in behaviour unbecoming a member of the Richmond Cosom Floor Hockey Association, the Association reserves the right to request a review of my actions by the Association's Executive which could result in sanctions up to, and including, immediate suspension of my membership from the Richmond Cosom Floor Hockey Association.
