Motion to amend the current Bylaw:

Rationale: (Why this motion is being put forward):

The current bylaw is not clear on who can vote or how to vote and does not allow hybrid voting.

Intended Outcome of the Motion (What is the desired effect of the change):

The intended outcome to be clarify who can vote and allow for hybrid voting.

Proposed to amend bylaw 4.7 (a)

(a) A member (as per 2.1) in good standing present at a meeting of members is entitle to one vote per registration.

- I. All voting members must be of age of majority.
- II. A member with multiple voting positions is entitled to only one vote.
- III. A member family with multiple youth registrations is entitled to one vote per registrant, to a maximum of 2.
- III A member that is not in good standing at the time the meeting is commenced shall not be entitled to vote at any meeting.

Proposed to amend bylaw 4.7 (c)

Voting shall be hybrid, when applicable. Voting in person shall by show of hand. Voting online must be by a valid format and membership status verified.

With the except of the election of directors of the Society, which shall be held by secret ballot as hereinafter provided by the Bylaws.
